Alan Jones is an internationally renowned film critic, journalist, author and broadcaster.

He is a director of the Film4 FrightFest, the UK's biggest fantasy festival and also one of Europe's largest.

His bestselling books include 'The Rough Guide To Horror Movies' and 'Saturday Night Forever: The Story of Disco', now in its third Italian print run under the title 'Love Train'.

He is well known in Italian film circles for producing two critically acclaimed documentaries, 'Mario Bava: Master of the Macabre' and 'Dario Argento: An Eye For Horror'.

He is programme consultant for the annual Trieste science+fiction festival and has been a head jury member at the Rome Fantasy Festival.

In 2012 Alan worked in the publicity capacity with the Manetti Bros on promoting their two movies L'ARRIVO DI WANG and PAURA 3D.

He also personally supervised the international publicity for the thriller TULPA, starring Claudia Gerini and Michele Placido, directed by rock star Federico Zampaglione.

Alan's biography of his friend Dario Argento, 'Dario Argento: The Man, The Myths & The Magic' is now in its second print run and is considered one of the seminal books on Italian genre filmmaking.
